


Rice Bowls





Diocese of Belleville Faith & Justice Internship

The Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) is the domestic, anti-poverty social justice program of the U.S. Catholic Bishops. This year, CCHD is offering a local paid internship for Catholics in our diocese to help promote the

important work of CCHD and to offer experience working with and on behalf of those in poverty. The internship will provide practical work in carrying out the mandate of CCHD, opportunities to develop relationships with community leaders, reflection on Catholic social teaching, and opportunities for sharing the experience with other CCHD interns. The internship is paid and requires 10-20 hours a week for up to 500 hours. Required internship training will occur in Washington DC on May 31-June 2. The internship could be started in the summer or the fall and would last through the school year or until the 500 hours are completed.
