





"Our faith formation begins through the faith of others, and my Maronite parents were instrumental in teaching me to do God's will. When I met the Religious Sisters of Mercy toward the end of my fourth year of medical school, I knew I had found the community where God was Calling me to love and serve Him."



Homeschool Family Mass With Bishop McGovern


