- **STEWARDSHIP.** Thank you to everyone who completed a Stewardship Commitment card and returned it already. Again, if you haven't, **please do complete one in the next few weeks and return it, to participate in this important part of the life of the**

Church, and to save us the time and postage costs to send another. The Stewardship Renewal is like Christmas for the parish: opening gifts that people are willing to put to work for the good of the parish and the whole Church.

- **BECOMING CATHOLIC.** The first pillar of Stewardship is Hospitality. Part of Christian hospitality is sharing with others the good news of what is happening here at the Cathedral, even inviting them to become part of what we're doing. Have you known anyone recently who expressed interest in the Catholic Church? Anyone who has questions? Our **Becoming Catholic** process (also known as RCIA or OCIA) is the perfect way for people to enter the waters of the Church gently. Please see the posting in the bulletin for more details.

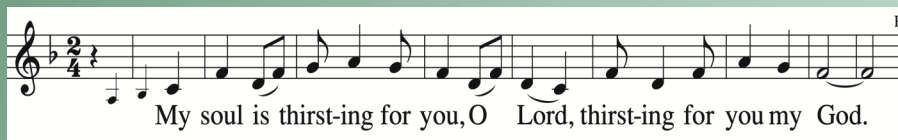
