From Fr. Godfrey

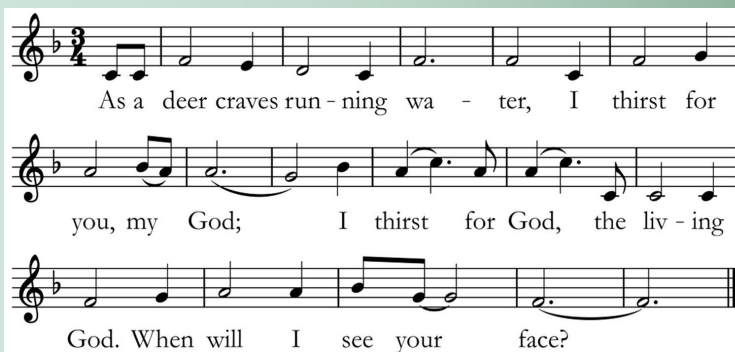
