### May 12, 2024



This past Thursday evening our "Becoming Catholic" gatherings came to a beautiful and spirit-filled close. This period of formation leading to the sacramental life of Christ through His Church was, by all accounts, a fulfilling journey of faith for all involved. Beginning in September, and meeting weekly, twenty-two children and adults from five Belleville area parishes, including nine from Cathedral, sought and followed through on a path of conversion and awareness of Christ's presence in their lives.

In recent weeks, since their entrance into the Church at the Easter Vigil, they have taken part in various faith-based encounters designed to show them what this life of the Catholic Church truly looks like, and how they are connected to Her. This time between Easter and Pentecost helps them discern more closely what the Holy Spirit is leading them to.

While our weekly sessions have come to an end, their journey not only continues, but really now begins. Nourished with the blessed food from heaven in the Holy Eucharist, and with our welcoming help, they will grow in closer union with God, through faith, hope and charity.
