From Fr. Godfrey

- **TRINITY SUNDAY.** Here we are, in the transition from Easter to Ordinary Time, with the first Sundays taking particular theological topics to celebrate. This week, it's Trinity Sunday. While millions of pages have been written about the Blessed Trinity, let's pay attention to one aspect. The book of Genesis teaches us clearly that we are made in the image and likeness of God, who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We are created in the likeness of the Triune God, who is perpetually in relationship. Life is so much richer when we acknowledge that foundation: none of us is an island, but we are all always in relationship with others, even when we feel most alone. The more we remember this, the more compassionate and connected we will be. Let us live in the image of God with gladness.

- **NEXT WEEKEND.** Next weekend is a big weekend for us at the Cathedral. Our seminarian, Levi James, will be ordained a deacon on Saturday at 10AM. On Saturday afternoon, at 4PM, we'll be celebrating the great work of Cathedral education at the Cathedral over the past 177 years, including the presence of several of the SSND Sisters who have taught here. Afterwards, we'll celebrate with the Tribute Food Truck Festival. On Sunday, at the 10:30 Mass, Bishop McGovern will celebrate his 30th anniversary of Priestly Ordination. Please congratulate Bishop McGovern on this milestone.

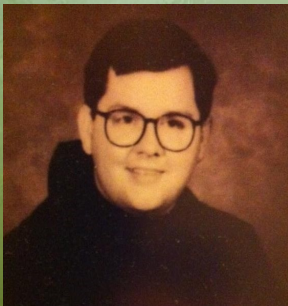
