From Fr. Godfrey

- **ABSENCE.** I'll be home Sunday night, June 16, from the retreat I'm giving to the Benedictine Sisters in Boerne, Texas, outside San Antonio. Someone asked last weekend why I do these retreats. It's a good question. There are a few reasons. As a Benedictine monk, I strongly believe that I have a duty not only to the Archabbey of Saint Meinrad or the Diocese of Belleville, but especially to the Benedictines to use the degree I earned. I discussed this commitment with Bishop McGovern before we agreed that I'd come to Belleville. Second, they provide me with some time for decompression. I love parish ministry, but there are literally hundreds of people who want and often need my attention. Going away to preach a retreat, while still work, brings a different pace and some needed refreshment. I'm extremely grateful for the work of the Benedictine Sisters in the Church and part of my gratitude is a generosity of spirit when it comes to their requests for retreats.

- **DAD.** Thank you to those who have been praying for my dad. Last week, he was in the hospital again with pneumonia. He doesn't like the hospital, but it does really help him be restrengthened.
