Making a Consistent
Gift to the Offertory

We are called to use our treasure wisely and in ways that reflect our love for Christ. And when we live our lives generously, we find joy, peace, and contentment. At Cathedral of St. Peter, each household is asked to give a specific percentage of income based on the biblical tithe:

5% to Cathedral of St. Peter
1% to the diocese ■ 4% to other charities
