Making a Consistent Gift to the Offertory

The act of generous and sacrificial giving is a sign of hope, which recognizes something greater is to come. Everything we have is a gift from God, including our treasure. Out of hope and gratitude, let us give God the first fruits of these gifts, with confidence that He will multiply the effects of our dependence on Him.

At the Cathedral of St. Peter, each household is asked to give a specific percentage of income based on the biblical tith:

5% to the Cathedral of St. Peter,
plus 1% to the diocese, and 4% to other charities

At the Cathedral of St. Peter, each household is asked to work toward giving 5% of their income to the parish. Some families may have difficulty reaching this goal at first. If so, try increasing your weekly gift incrementally until you reach an amount that you know is right for you.
